## ORDER

UPON CONSIDERATION by the Court of the request by Robert Fink to have the Court unseal its copy of the 1972 interview of Alfred C. Baldwin III by Los Angeles <u>Times</u> reporters Jack Nelson and Ronald Ostrow, which was sealed on January 17, 1973, and this Court having entered an Order to Show Cause on August 22, 1980, as to why the transcript of this interview, subject to certain deletions, should not be unsealed and made available to the public,

AND IT APPEARING to the Court that no objection has been filed within the time provided in the Order to Show Cause,

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING that there is no longer any reason for most of the transcript of the Baldwin interview to remain sealed, it is by the Court this 3 day of October, 1980,

ORDERED that the seal be lifted on the transcript of the Baldwin interview and that the Clerk of Court make copies of the interview available to the public subject to the deletion of certain passages on pages 48,749,59,61,62,71 and 72 (alluding to the contents of illegally intercepted conversations).
