- 1. On May 24, 2017, this Court ruled on several pending miscellaneous matters, including from this petitioner. Specifically, the Court noted several items of correspondence that Court the received, and ordered that the correspondence be construed as a petition to unseal the documents specified in the correspondence. Undersigned counsel contacted petitioner to request an additional thirty days in which to discuss with petitioner the specific documents that he continues to seek, whether those documents included grand jury materials, and whether there was a possibility of resolving this matter without further involvement from the Court.

3. Petitioner consented to extending the current deadline thirty days, which would make the government's response due August 25, 2017. For the foregoing reasons, the government's unopposed request for an extension of time should be granted.
